About Seoul, South Korea

Seoul officially the Seoul Special Metropolitan City, is the capital and largest metropolis of South Korea. Seoul forms the heart of the Seoul Capital Area, and includes the surrounding Incheon metropolis and Gyeonggi province, altogether home to roughly half of the country's population. Seoul is in the northwest of South Korea. Seoul proper comprises 605.25 km² (233.69 sq mi), with a radius of approximately 15 km (9 mi), roughly bisected into northern and southern halves by the Han River. The Han River and its surrounding area played an important role in Korean history. Under the Köppen climate classification, Seoul has a humid continental climate, also bordering a humid subtropical climate. The suburbs of Seoul are generally cooler than the center of Seoul because of the urban heat island effect. Summers are generally hot and humid, with the East Asian monsoon taking place from June until September. August, the warmest month, has average high and low temperatures of 34.6 and 25.4 °C (94 and 78 °F) with higher temperatures possible. Winters are usually cold to freezing with average January high and low temperatures of 1.5 and -5.9 °C (34.7 and 21.4 °F) and are generally much drier than summers, with an average of 28 days of snow annually. Seoul is the business and financial hub of South Korea.
