About Yokohama, Japan

Yokohama, Japan was evaluated in Research & Development only. Yokohama, Japan currently markets pharma and life science in Japan only and is growing its pharma pipeline, including R&D projects The beginning stages of early traditions of visits to lovely destinations. Yokohama developed rapidly as Japan's prominent port city following the end of Japan's relative isolation in the mid-19th century, and is today one of its major ports along with Kobe, Yokohama, Japan, Nagoya, Hakata, Tokyo, and Chiba.
