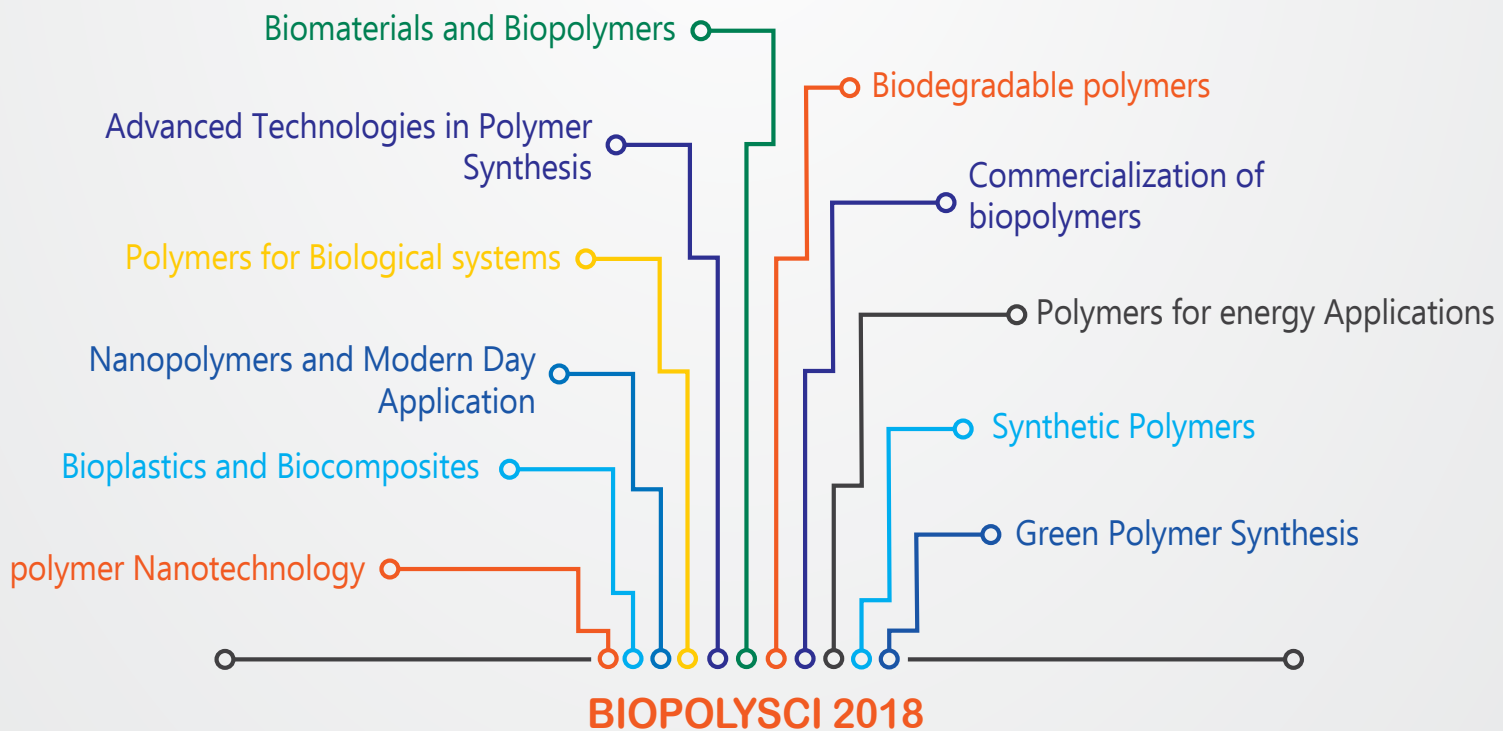

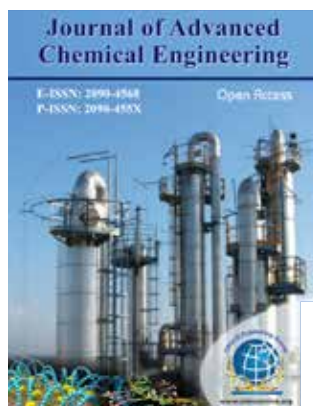

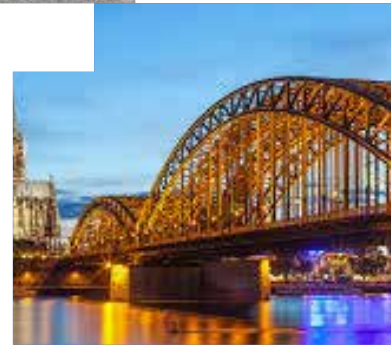

Depleting fossil fuel resources and rising environmental pollution and demand for new effective materials have given rise to new technologies in biopolymer and polymer in both academia and industry. Bucharest is the industrial and commercial centre of Romania. Bucharest is situated in south-eastern part of the country around the Dambovitza River. Its population is roughly 2.5 million and a total area only 226 square kilometres (87 sq mi). Bucharest is easily the largest city in Romania and the 6th largest city in the European union as far as population is concerned. Bucharest has several monuments and landmarks. The most prominent one is the palace of the parliament, the largest parliament building in the world. The palace holds the Romanian parliament and also the National Museum of Contemporary Art. This building has one of the largest convention centres of the world.
