About Australia

Breast Cancer Therapies was the second most commonly diagnosed cancer in Australia in 2013. During 2013, it was also the most commonly diagnosed cancer in females. It is estimated that it will become the most commonly diagnosed cancer in 2017 among both persons and females (Table 1). This is because the incidence of prostate cancer (which was the most commonly diagnosed cancer in 2013) is expected to continue to decline.

In 2013, there were 16,045 new cases of Breast Cancer Therapies diagnosed in Australia (142 males and 15,902 females). In 2017, it is estimated that 17,730 new cases of Breast Cancer Therapies will be diagnosed in Australia (144 males and 17,586 females).

In 2013, the age-standardised incidence rate was 64 cases per 100,000 persons (1.1 for males and 123 for females). In 2017, it is estimated that the age-standardised incidence rate will be 64 cases per 100,000 persons (1.0 for males and 124 for females). For females, the incidence rate of Breast Cancer Therapies is expected to increase with age until age group 65–69, before decreasing, while for males the incidence rate is expected to remain steady across ages.
