

# About Singapore

Singapore, an island nation in Southeast Asia lies one degree (137 kilometers (85 mi)) north of the equator, at the southern tip of the Malay Peninsula, with Indonesia's Riau Islands toward the south and Malaysia toward the north. Singapore's region comprises of one primary island alongside 62 different islets. Singapore is a worldwide trade, back and transport center. Singapore is a restorative tourism center; nearly around 200,000 outsiders look for therapeutic care every year. The city features mainly incorporate Gardens by the Bay, Merlion Park, Singapore Flyer, Universal Studios Singapore, Buddha Tooth Relic Temple, Masjid Sultan, Singapore Zoo and Underwater World.

The high rises and metros of a cutting edge, rich city with a mixture of Chinese, Malay and Indian impacts and a tropical atmosphere, with delectable nourishment, great shopping and a dynamic night-life scene make an extraordinary stopover to the area. The decent variety of nourishment is touted as motivation to visit the nation, and the assortment of sustenance speaking to various ethnicities is seen by the legislature as an image of its multiculturalism.

A tropical rainforest atmosphere is found in Singapore with no separate seasons, uniform temperature and weight, high stickiness, and plenteous precipitation. Temperatures extend from 22 to 35 °C (72 to 95 °F). While temperature does not fluctuate incredibly consistently, there is a wetter storm season from November to January. The normal temperature in the long stretch of August is 24 °C to 30 °C.

# Singapore City Attractions



The body symbolises Singapore's humble beginnings as a fishing village when it was called Temasek, meaning 'sea town' in Old Javanese. Its head represents Singapore's original name, Singapura, or 'lion city' in Malay. Today, you can glimpse this legend at Merlion Park. Spouting water from its mouth, the Merlion statue stands tall at 8.6 metres and weighs 70 tonnes.

Singapore Flyer is basically an observation wheel which surges 165 metres and it is Asia's largest giant wheels. At the flyer, you can get insight of the technology behind the wheel and also get a sneak peek into the history and evolution of Singapore. This ride can brush your knowledge and thus, it is the best attraction for kids.



Gardens by the Bay will take you to an imaginative place and it is a tourist hotspot for all the good reason. The Marina Bay holds amazing Supertree Grove and it is comeliest at night. It gives an impression of being in an imaginative place with all sorts of attractions to visit such as Flower Dome and Cloud Forest which gives an eye-popping sight to the spectators. The Gardens by the Bay complex is divided into three bays – central, east and south. Thankfully, it contains a promenade where you can stop for a coffee or dine when the tour gets tiresome.

Clarke Quay is a nightlife destination in Singapore that is packed with food joints, loud pubs, rooftop bars and spirited discotheques. This place is thriving with madness and enjoyment and a lot of travellers' even locals consider this hotspot to spend an eventful evening. As you stroll along side the buzzing streets, prepare to get dazed with all the neon lights, delicious food, and reflection of the skyscrapers on the glittering Singapore River. Clarke Quay also has something for the adventure buffs, bungee jumping at 'G-Max Reverse Bungy' will thug your heart as you soar 60 feet into the air at a speed of 200 km/hour.
