About Singapore

Singapore, an island city-state off southern Malaysia, is a global financial center with a tropical climate and multicultural population. It has been Southeast Asia's most modern city for over a century. As of 2015 there are 7 public hospitals, 9 national speciality centres, 10 private hospitals, and private community hospitals are located. Singaporean hospitals are equipped with advanced medical technology and can offer edge treatments with outcomes comparable to renowned institutions worldwide. Singapore is ranked as one of the world's top destinations for plastic surgery. The IMD World Competitiveness Yearbook ranked Singapore's Health Infrastructure 3rd out of 55 countries. Singaporean orthopedics market includes the success of Singapore General Hospital as the first hospital in Southeast Asia to perform minimally invasive spine surgery. The Medical Tourism Association has identified Singapore as the most prominent hub for foreigners to travel and receive surgical care. Singapore hosts the regional secretariats of prominent international healthcare organizations such as the International Diabetes Federation (IDF), and Joint Commission International (JCI). The Asia-Pacific office of the Healthcare Information and Management Systems Society (HIMSS) is also in Singapore. International research organizations that have established their presence here include the American Association for Cancer Research, Duke University, and Johns Hopkins University. Companies and scientists are working with these research institutes to accelerate drug discovery and develop novel therapies for unmet healthcare needs. Major healthcare providers in the public sector include Sing Health and National Healthcare Group.
