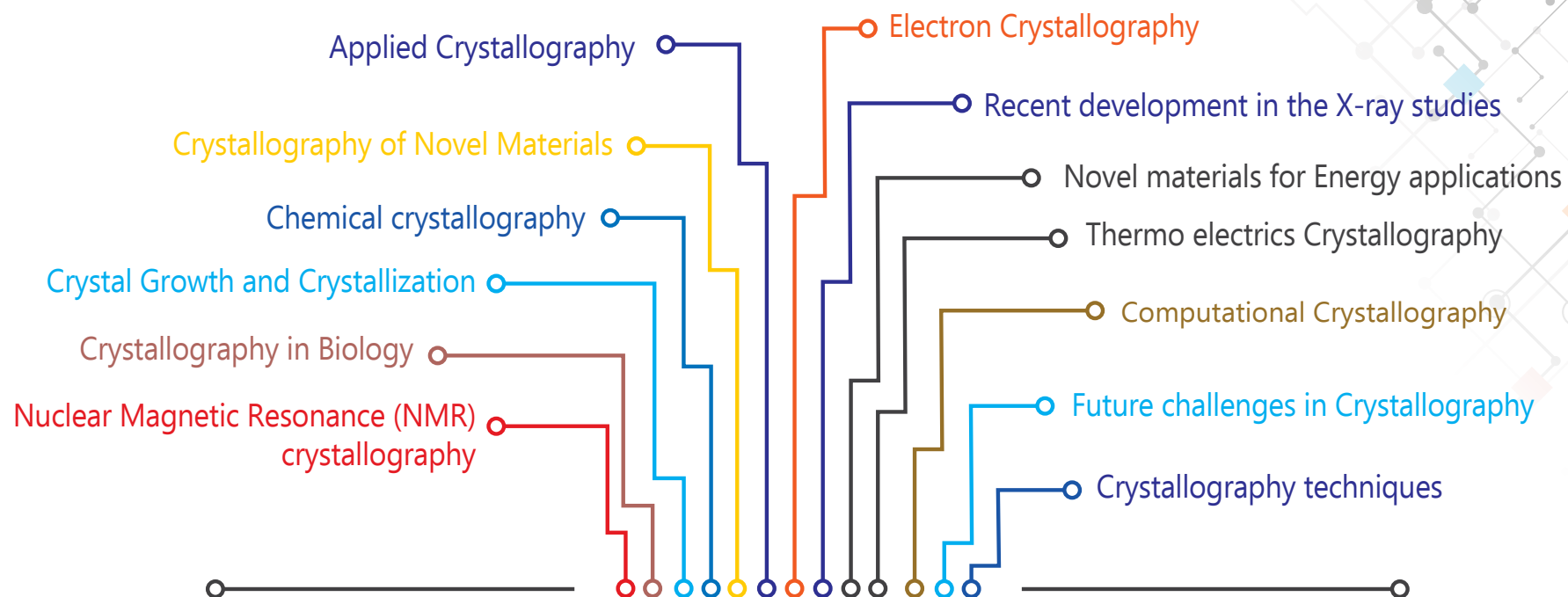

Venue & Hospitality

Bucharest is the most prosperous and largest city of Romania and is the centre of Romanian media, culture, and art. Its architecture is a mix of historical and is known for the forested region of Transylvania, also ringed by the Carpathian Mountains. It is one of the main industrial centres and transportation hubs of Eastern Europe. The city has big convention facilities, educational institutes, cultural venues, traditional “shopping arcades”, and recreational areas. Romania’s preserved medieval town include Sighișoara, and there are fortified churches and castles, mostly clifftop Bran Castle and long associated with the Dracula legend. Bucharest is the capital of Romania, where megalomaniac monuments, including “House of the People” (now called as the Palace of Parliament), was built during the Ceaușescu’s regime.

Famous Attractions in Bucharest include: the Carpathian mountains, salt mines, George Enescu, medieval fortresses, sculptor Constantin Brancusi, Eugene Ionesco, “Dacia” cars, Dracula, stuffed cabbage leaves, primeval dense forests, the Black Sea, Nadia Comaneci, Gheorghe Hagi, sunflower fields, wolves and bears, painted monasteries, the Danube Delta, Romania is situated in the north most region of the Balkan Peninsula on the western shores of the Black Sea.

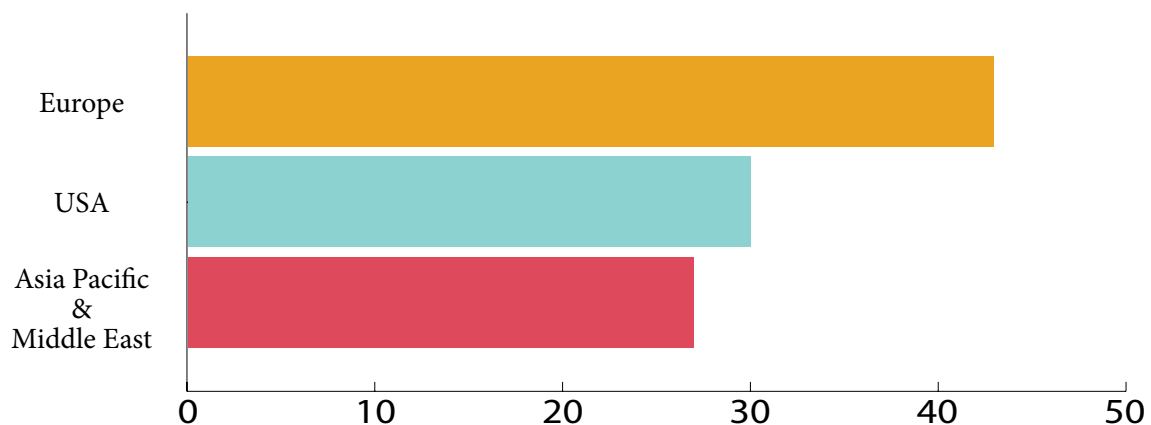

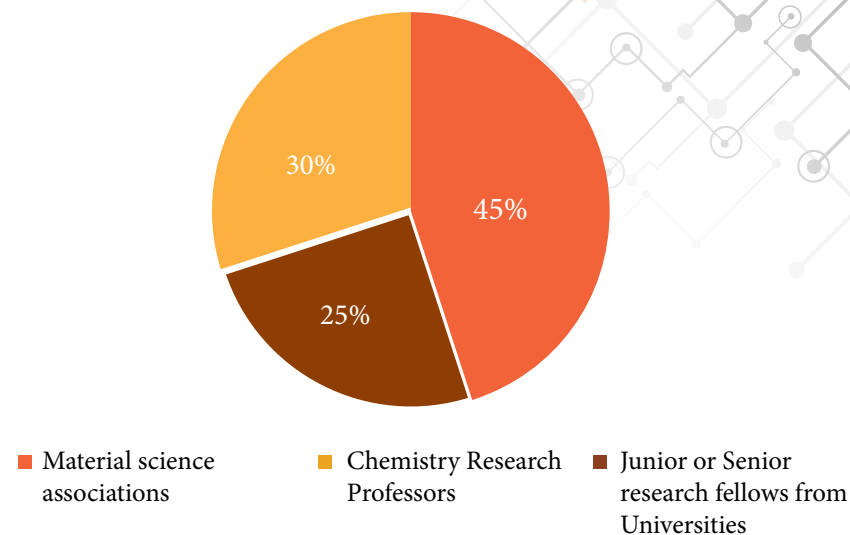
Exhibitors and sponsors have the opportunity for face-to-face networking with leading scientists, increase brand awareness, and develop collaborations with an international audience.
