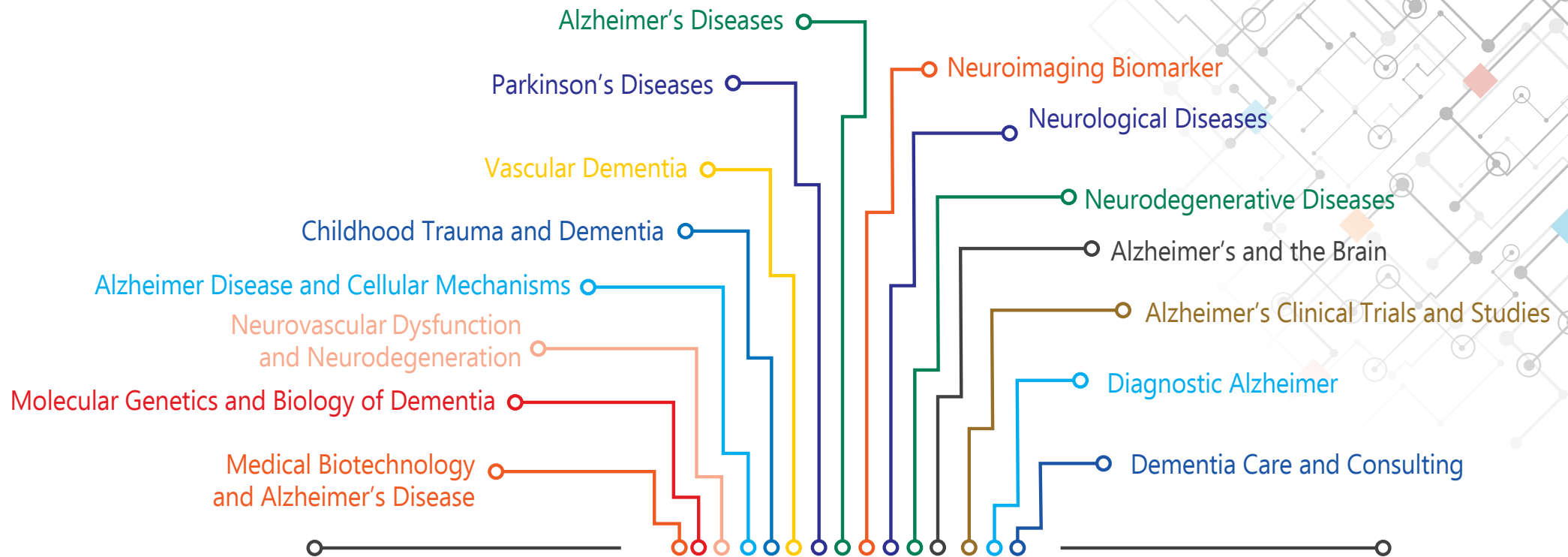

# Venue & Hospitality

Johannesburg is otherwise called Jozi, Joburg, and eGoli) is the biggest city in South Africa and one of the 50 biggest urban territories on the planet. It is the common capital and biggest city of Gauteng, which is the wealthiest territory in South Africa. 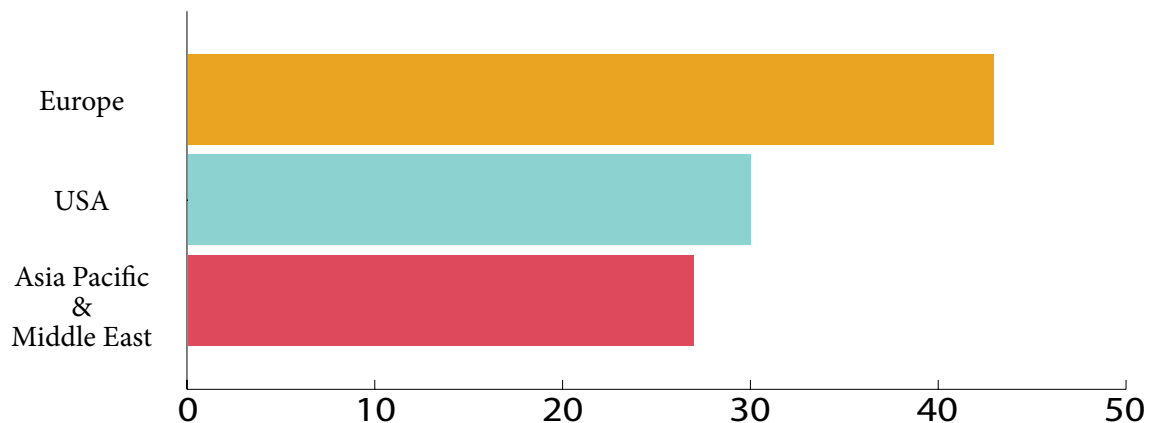

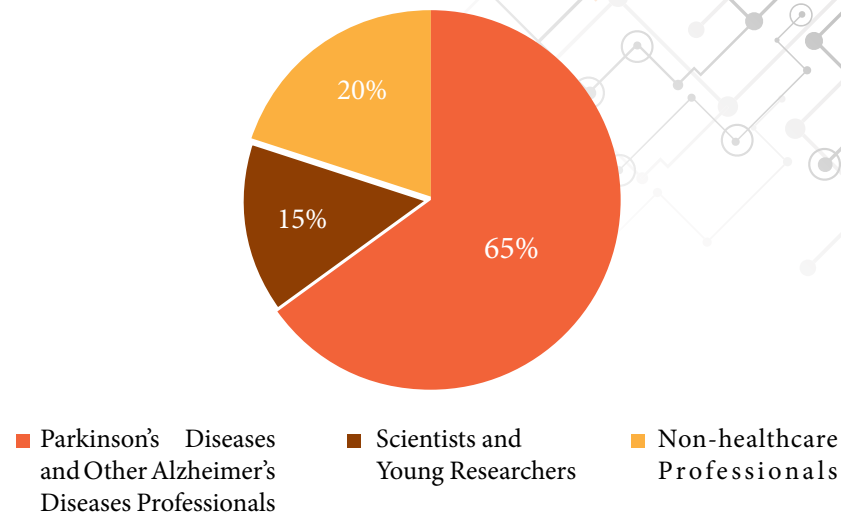
