# Venue

Osaka is located in the humid subtropical climate zone with four distinct seasons. Its winters are generally mild, the flower fields offer a wide variety of flowers in the month of May however, the region is most famous for its lavender which attracts large numbers of visitors every summer, when the plants are in full bloom. Spring in Osaka starts off mild, but ends up being hot and humid. Greater Osaka has an extensive network of railway lines, comparable to that of Greater Tokyo. Osaka is served by two airports outside of the city, Kansai International Airport which handles primarily international passenger flights and Osaka International Airport which handles mostly domestic services and some international cargo flights

Osaka is the second largest metropolitan area in Japan and serves a major economic hub. Historically a merchant city, Osaka has also been known as the "Nation's Kitchen". With a population of 2.5 million, Osaka is Japan's third largest and second most important city. It has been the economic powerhouse of the Kansai region for many centuries. The city's west side has the main port as well as a tourist destination with attractions such as Kyocera Dome, Universal Studios Japan, Osaka aquarium, Minami, Osaka castle, Umeda sky building and the Tempozan Harbour Village. Osaka is known for its food, both in Japan and abroad. Author Michael Booth and food critic Francois Simon of Le Figaro have both suggested that Osaka is the food capital of the world. Osaka's culinary prevalence is the result of a location that has provided access to high quality ingredients, a high population of merchants, and close proximity to the ocean and waterway trade.

Osaka has a large number of wholesalers and retail shops, the stores along the arcade include commodities, clothing, and catering outlets. Osaka is known for its food, in Japan and abroad. Osaka is known for its fine sake, which is made with fresh water from the prefecture's mountains.
