Hanoi is the capital of Vietnam.it covers an area of 3,328.9 square kilometres(1,285 sq mi) with an estimated population of 8.2 millions as of 2019,It is the second most productive economic centre of Vietnam. Hanoi is the commercial, cultural and educated centre of Northern Vietnam.it Having estimated nominal GDP of US\$32.8 billion.

Vietnam is a country in southeast Asia located on the extreme east of the Indochinese peninsula. The Nation shares its land borders with china,Laos and cambodia.vietnam however is also a country with a long history and ancient traditions

Hanoi had many official and unofficial names throughout history.Hanoi contains three basic kinds of terrain, which are the delta area, the midland area and mountainous zone. In general, the terrain is gradually lower from the north to the south and from the west to the east, with the average height ranging from 5 to 20 meters above the sea level. The hills and mountainous zones are located in the northern and western part of the city. The highest peak is at Ba Vi with 1281 m, located west of the city proper.
