Hong Kong is today a world-class financial, trading and business centre and, indeed, a great world city which is positioned at the mouth of the Pearl River Delta on the coast of southern China. Hong Kong is ideally positioned at the centre of rapidly developing East Asia. Chinese and English are the official languages. Hong Kong is an international and cosmopolitan city, known for its business-friendly environment, Hong Kong's financial markets are distinguished by a high degree of liquidity. Hong Kong is a highly mobile city, where people make over 11 million trips daily, using an efficient, economic and multi-modal public transport system that includes railways, trams, buses, public light buses, taxis and ferries. Hong Kong is a global communications hub and has an excellent communications infrastructure. It consists of 4 main areas: Hong Kong Island, Kowloon, the New Territories, and the Outlying Islands. Kowloon and the New Territories are on a peninsula, accounting for the bulk of Hong Kong's land. The New Territories link Hong Kong to mainland China. There are mainly 234 islands in the proximity of Hong Kong. The island is in the southern part of the territory. The largest islands are Lantau Island and Hong Kong Island.
