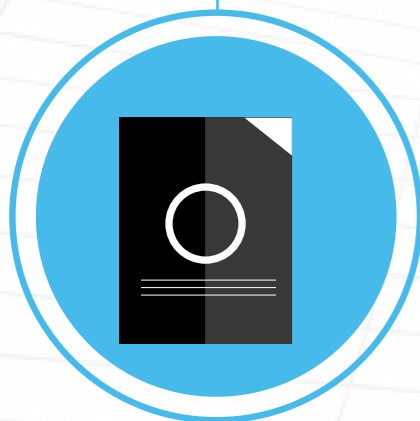
- ☞ The forum will provide an opportunity for collegial interaction with other speakers and established celebrative across the globe.
