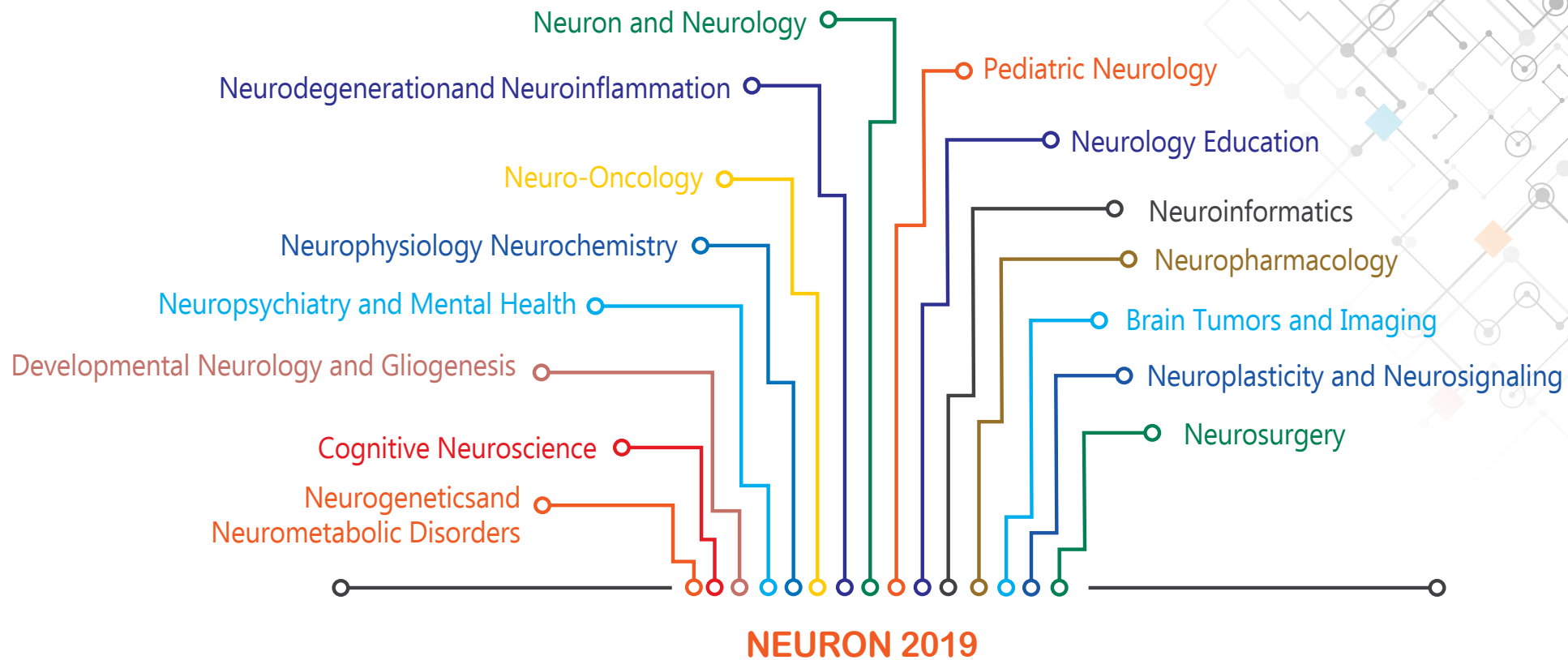

- The “City of Love”, the streets of Paris overflow with culture, art, beauty, and history. Whether searching out Monet’s Water Lilies at Musée de l’Orangerie, climbing the many steps of Sacré-Cœur, standing before the Eiffel Tower in awe, or searching out the best crepes along the Seine, Paris is a city that captures the hearts of millions every year.
- There are in total 1,803 monuments and 173 museums in Paris. There are also 450 parks and gardens in the city, spread out across more than 1,200 acres. There are more than 400 movie screens in Paris, a hundred of which are operated by France’s government art program, Art et Essai. There are on average 10 film or commercial shoots in the streets of Paris each day. Shooting in Paris is free except for scenes shot in a garden, museum, or swimming pool. 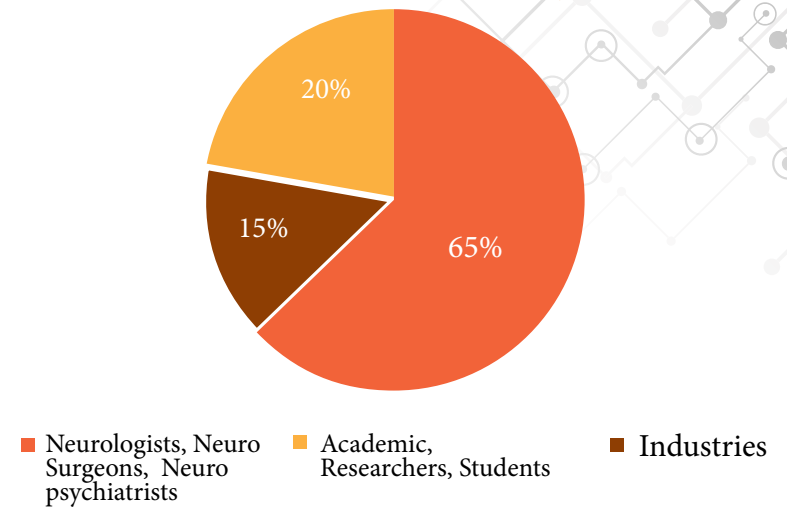
Exhibitors and sponsors have the opportunity for face-to-face networking with leading scientists and clinicians, increase brand awareness, and develop collaborations with an international audience.
