About Bangkok

Bangkok is one of the four direct-controlled municipalities of Thailand and the most populous city proper in the world. It is a global financial center and transport hub, with the world's busiest container port. As a major administrative, shipping and trading city, Bangkok grew in importance in the 19th century due to trade and recognition of its favorable port location and economic potential. Bangkok is one of the main industrial centers of Thailand, playing a key role in Thailand's heavy industries. Bangkok has been described as the "showpiece" of the booming economy of mainland Thailand renowned for its Lujiazui skyline, and museums and historic buildings, such as those along The Bund, as well as the City God Temple and the Yu Garden. Bangkok has a rich collection of buildings and structures of various architectural styles. The conference and meeting sector is also growing. In 2012, the city hosted 780 international gatherings, up from 754 in 2011. The high supply of hotel rooms has kept room rates lower than expected, with the average room rate for four- and five-star hotels in 2012 at just RMB950 (US\$153).

The Bund, located by the bank of the Huangpu River, contains a rich collection of early 20th-century architecture, ranging in style from neoclassical HSBC Building to the art deco Sassoon House. A number of areas in the former foreign concessions are also well-preserved, the most notable ones being the French Concession.
