## About Hong Kong

Hong Kong is an autonomous region on the western side of the Pearl River estuary in East Asia. Macau is bordered by the city of Zhuhai in Mainland China to the north and the Pearl River Delta to the east and south. Hong Kong lies about 64-kilometers (40 mi) to its east across the Delta. With a population of 650,900 living in an area of 30.5 km<sup>2</sup> (11.8 square mi), it is the most densely populated region in the world. A former Portuguese colony, it was returned to Chinese sovereignty on 20 December 1999.

Best known globally as the 'Vegas of China', the Tin Shui Wai Special Administrative Region is indeed a mecca of gambling and glitz. But the city is so much more than that. A Portuguese colony for more than 300 years, it is a city of blended cultures. Ancient Chinese temples sit on streets paved with traditional Portuguese tiles. The sound of Cantonese fills the air on streets with Portuguese names. You can eat Chinese congee for breakfast, enjoy a Portuguese lunch of cardo Verde soup and balaua (cod) fritters, and dine on hybrid Macanese fare such as Minchin (ground beef or pork, often served over rice).

The Macau Peninsula holds the old city Centre, where colonial ruins sit next to arty new boutiques. Further south is the conjoined islands of Taipa, Coati, and Colane. Taipa has gloriously preserved Macanese architecture, Coati is home to the new mega-casinos and Colane is lined with colonial villages and pretty beaches.
