## About Sydney

Australia is situated between the Pacific and Indian oceans in the Southern Hemisphere. Australia is a federal parliamentary constitutional monarchy. Although Australia has no official language, English has always been entrenched as the de facto national language. Australia has the third and seventh highest life expectancy of males and females respectively in the world.

Total expenditure on health (including private sector spending) is around 9.8% of GDP. Australia introduced universal health care in 1975. Known as Medicare, it is now nominally funded by an income tax expense known as the Medicare levy, at present the set at 2%. The states govern hospitals and attached outpatient services, while the Commonwealth assets the Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme (subsidizing the costs of medicines) and general practice.

Sydney is located on the east coast of the country in the state of New South Wales. It is Australia's biggest and most cosmopolitan city and an essential stop on any traveler's itinerary on an Australia vacation. Around the city there is a wonderland of national parks, forests, mountains, river valleys and historic riverside towns. The Sydney area has been inhabited by indigenous Australians for at least 30,000 years. Early Sydney was molded by the adversity suffered by early settlers. The military colonial government was relying on the army, the New South Wales Corps.
