## About Yokohama

Yokohama is the second largest city in Japan by population, after Tokyo, and the most populated township of Japan. It is the capital city of Kanagawa Prefecture. It lies on Tokyo Bay, south of Tokyo, in the Kantō region of the main island of Honshu. It is a major commercial hub of the Greater Tokyo Area

### Top 10 Places to Visit in Yokohama:

- 1) Minato Mirai: Minato Mirai 21 was designed as a large master-planned development and new urban center planned to attach Yokohama's traditionally important areas and commercial centers of Kannai and the Yokohama Station area.
- 2) Ōsanbashi Pier: In the port of Yokohama, Ōsanbashi Pier is the main international passenger pier located in Naka Ward, Yokohama, Japan
- 3) Enoshima: Enoshima is a mini island off the Shōnan coast of Japan's Kanagawa Prefecture
- 4) Yokohama Chinatown: Japan's largest Chinatown, with around 260 Chinese-owned stores & eateries & a colorful entry gate.
- 5) Yokohama Landmark Tower: Skyscraper with panoramic views. This huge tower with a hotel, mall & offices also has an observation area with 360-degree views.
- 6) Yokohama Red Brick Warehouse: Former brick warehouse, now a shopping & cultural center with cafes, stores & seasonal events.
- 7) Yokohama Hakkeijima Sea Paradise: Opened in 1993, this amusement park offers an aquarium with rides, sea life shows & a marina.
- 8) Shin-Yokohama Rāmen Museum: Traditional street food court with stores offering samples of ramen dishes from different regions.
- 9) Yokohama Marine Tower: Light house built in 1961 and Iconic waterfront tower, with an observation deck for harbor views.
- 10) Engaku-ji: Zen Buddhist complex, founded in 1282, with temples, gates, a giant bell & a relic of the Buddha
