OSAKA is the most unique city in Japan, Located at a latitude of 34°35' 46'degrees north and a longitude of 135°23' 36'degrees east. Osaka is roughly in the middle of Japan (about 500km west of Tokyo) for 1400 years, Osaka has been a gathering place. The city has long conducted business not only nationwide but also with China and the Korean Peninsula, playing an important role as a centre of trade and cultural exchange. The Osaka regions continued to play an important role in Japan's development. Osaka's development into a major city began in the mid-sixteenth century, a time of great social instability and frequent internal warfare. Local feudal lords acted autonomously, unrestrained by a weak central government. The best time to travel to Osaka in Japan The months May, June, July, September and October have nice weather with a good average temperature. On average, and the warmest month are July and August a lot of rain (rainy season) falls in the months: March, April, May, June, July, August, September and October. Warmest month is August. Coolest month is January. June is the wettest month.
